

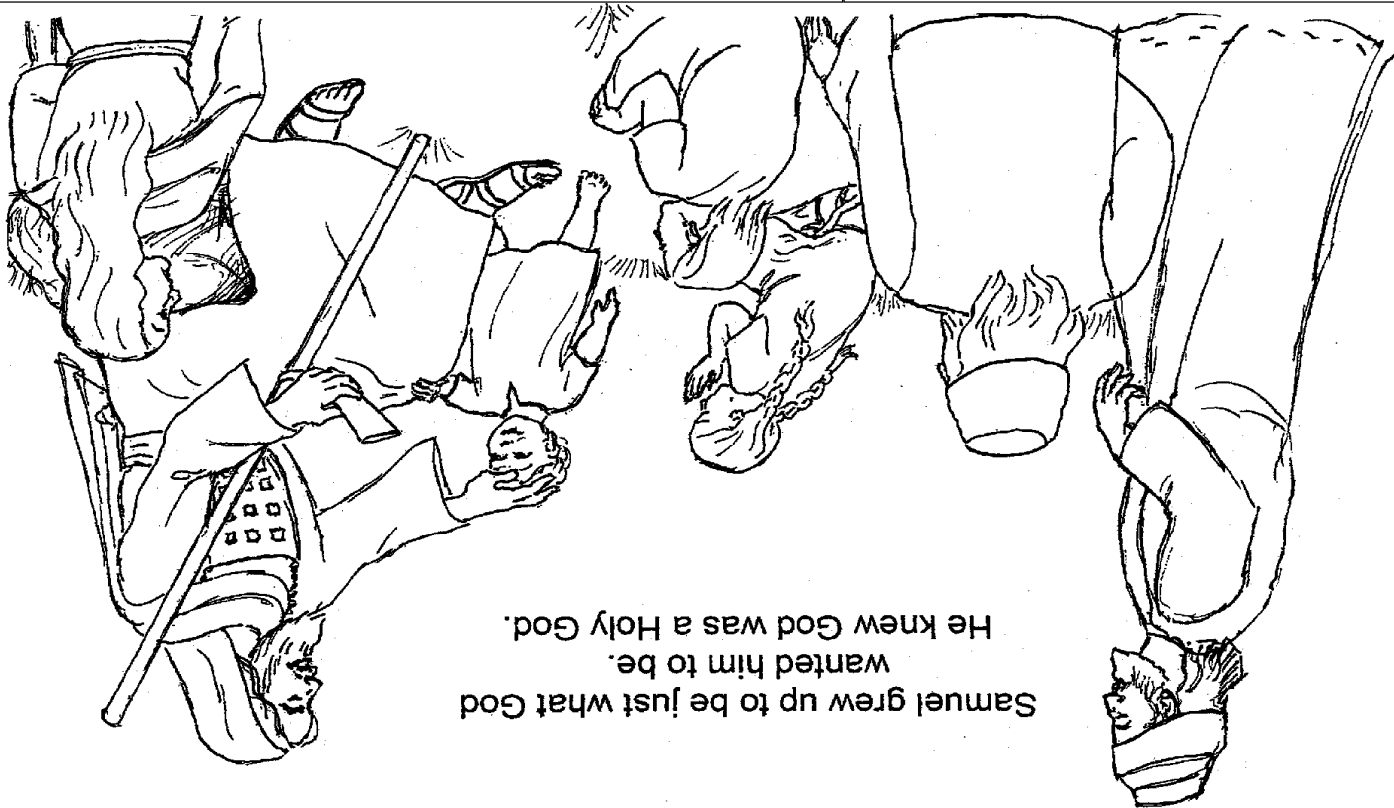

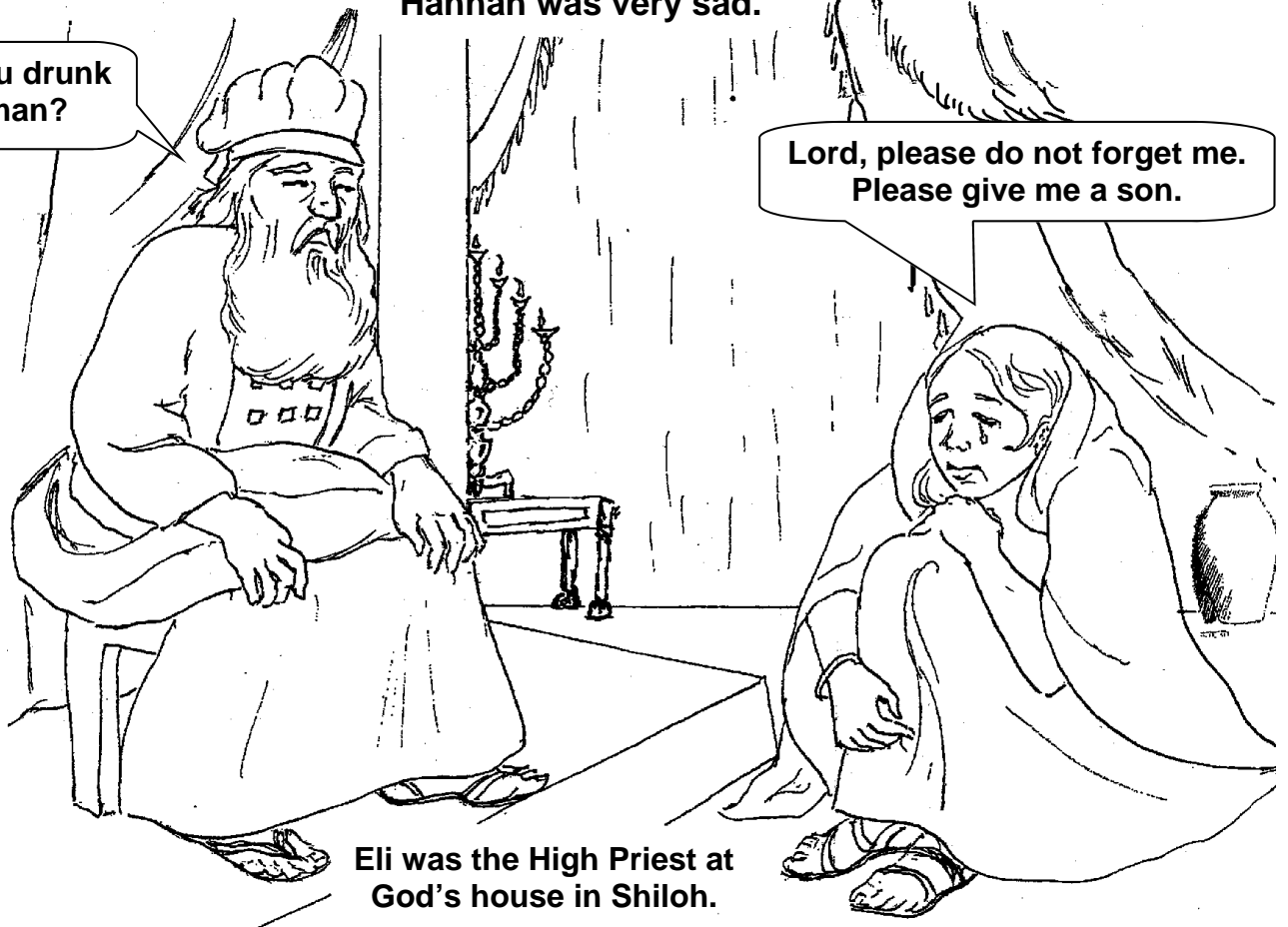




Hannah and her husband had no children.

Please give me a son.

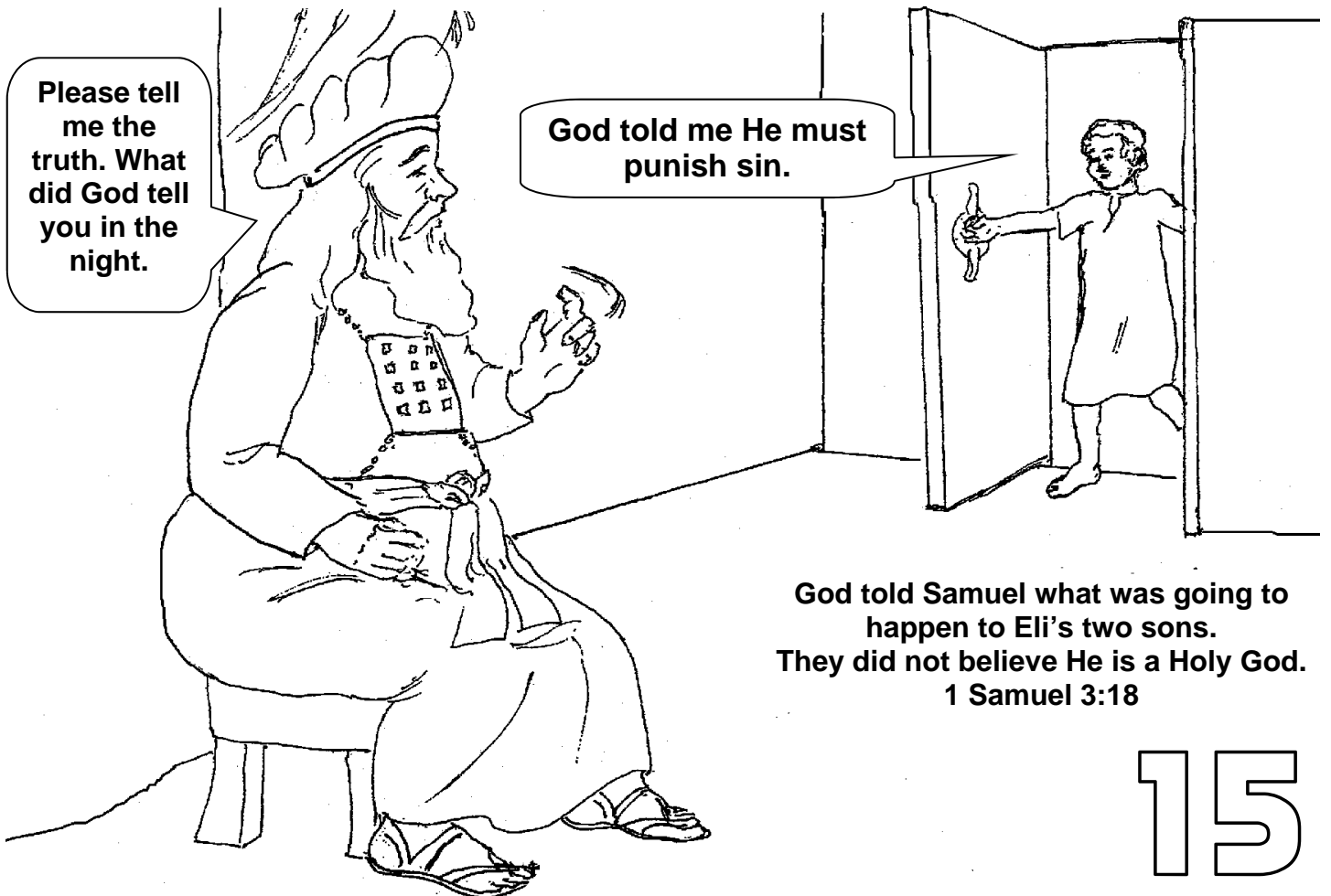

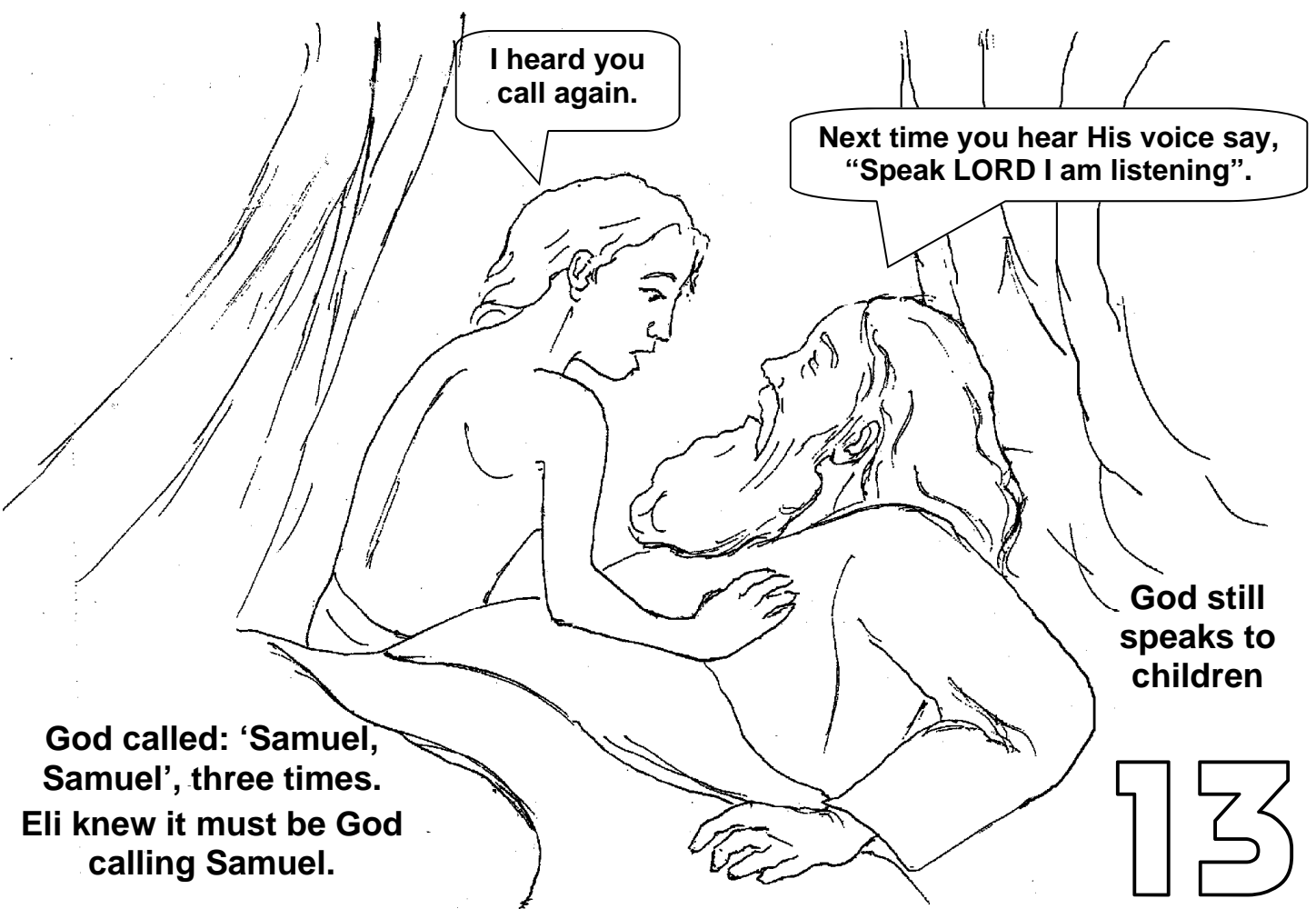

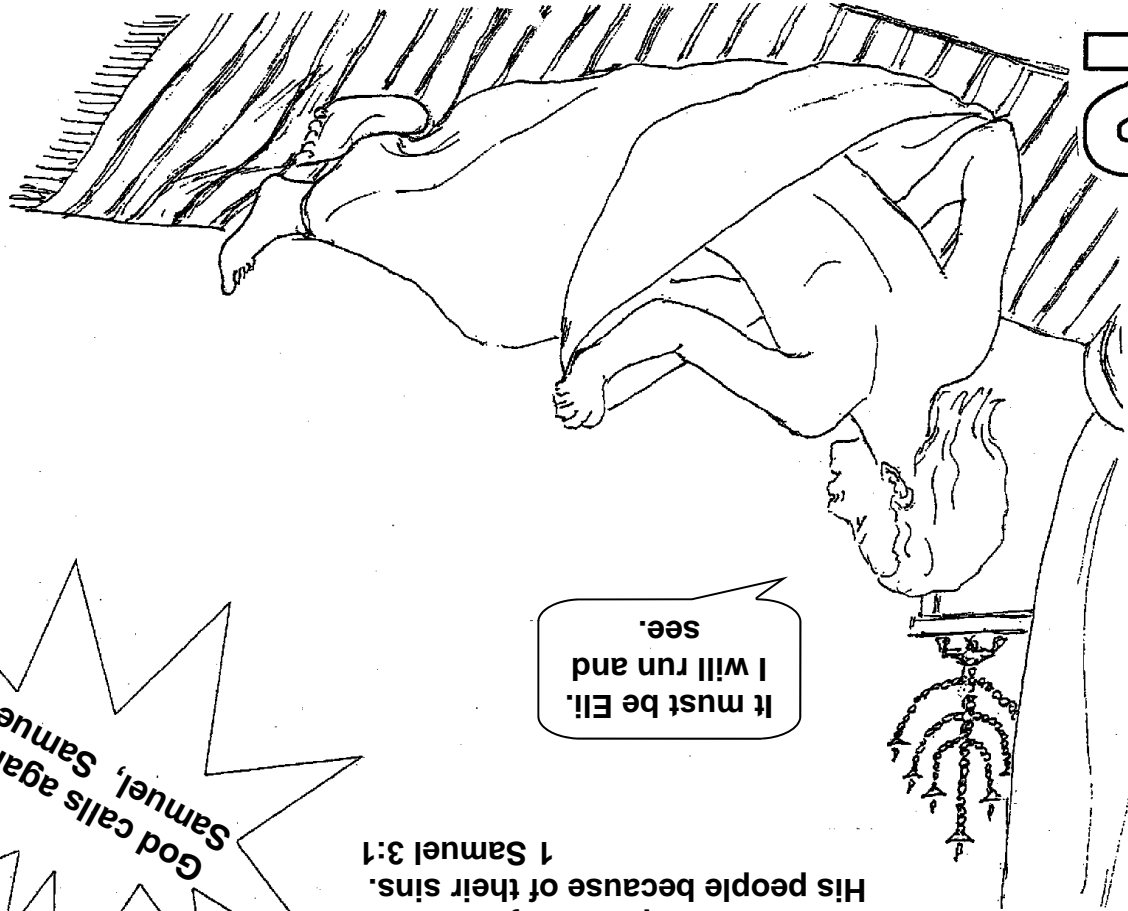


Because God answered my prayer, I want my son to live here with you.

Your son will serve the LORD.

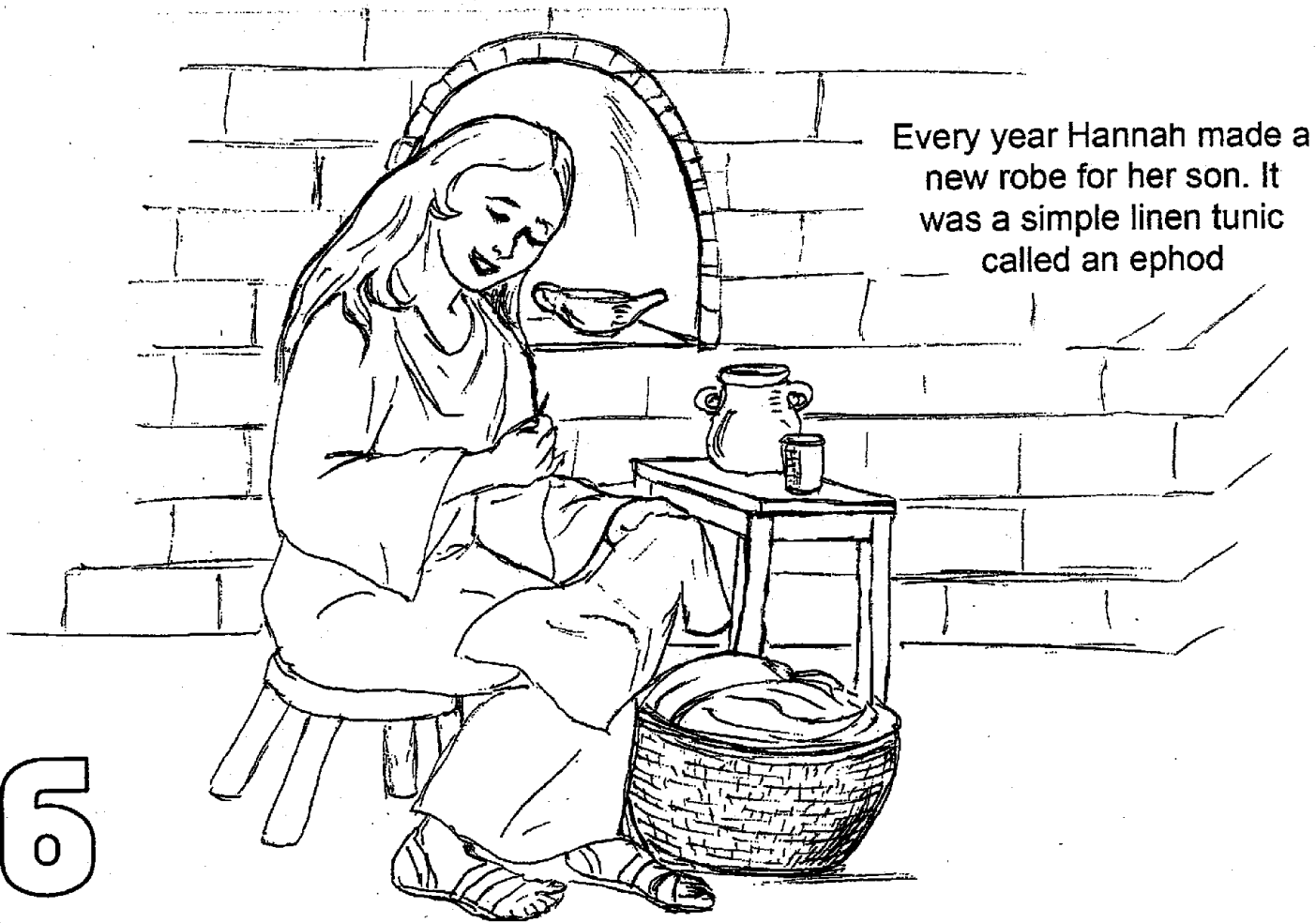
HANNAH KEPT HER PROMISE

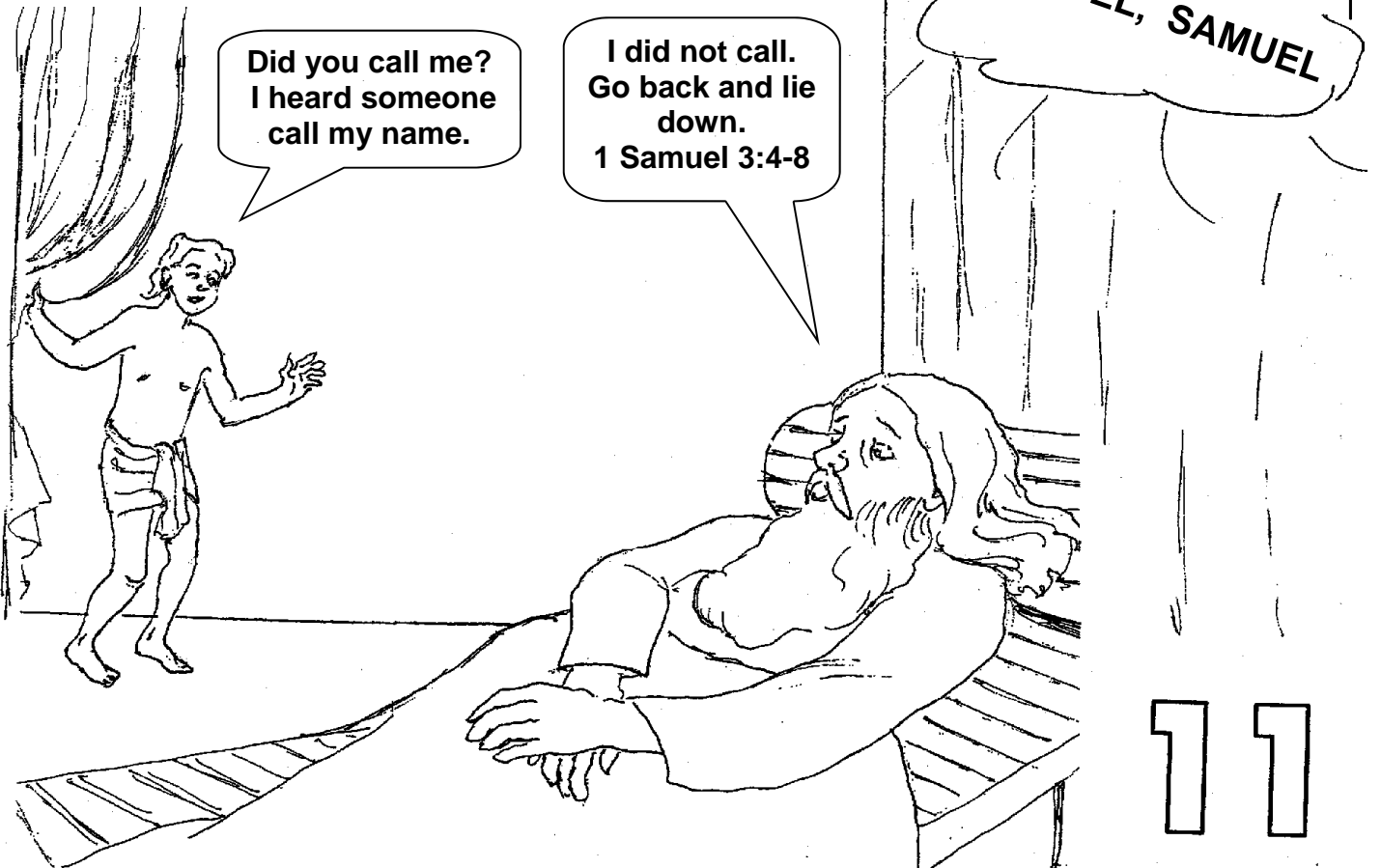
God calls again, Samuel, Samuel.
