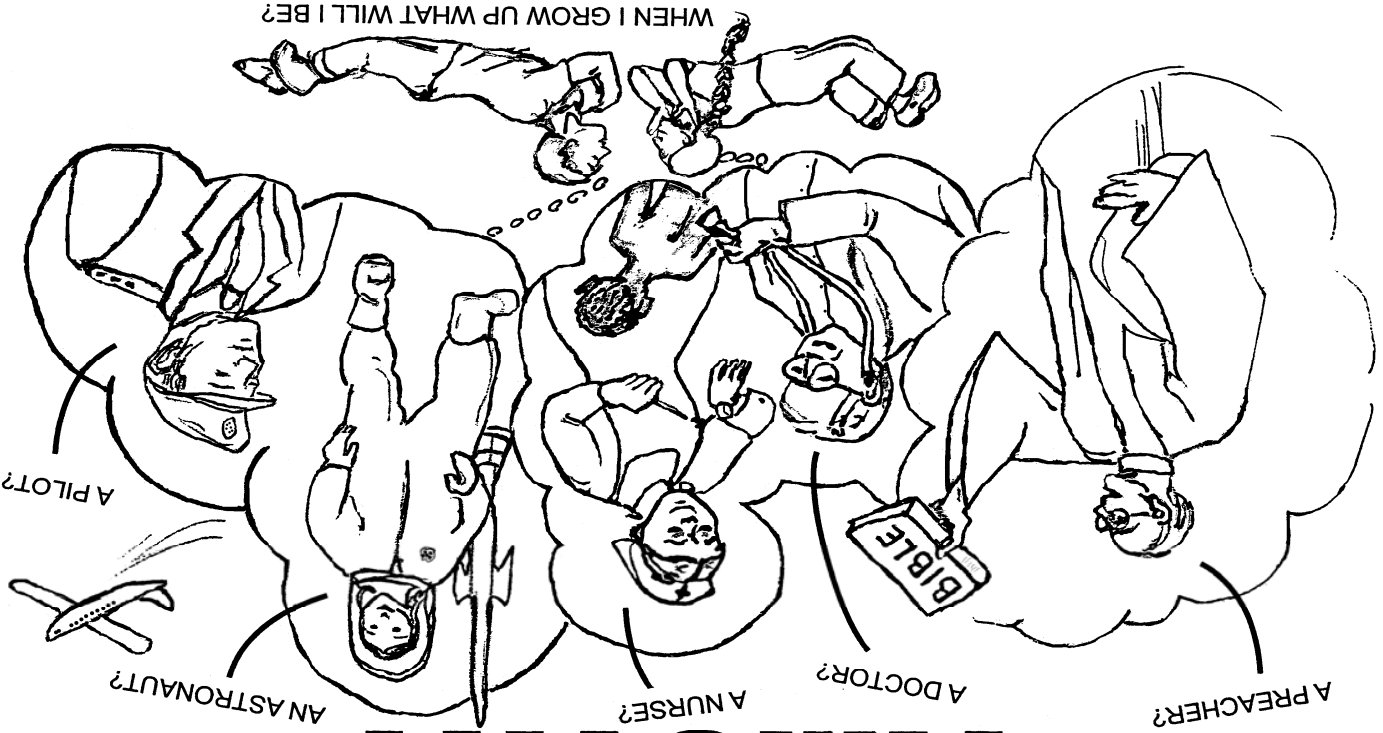

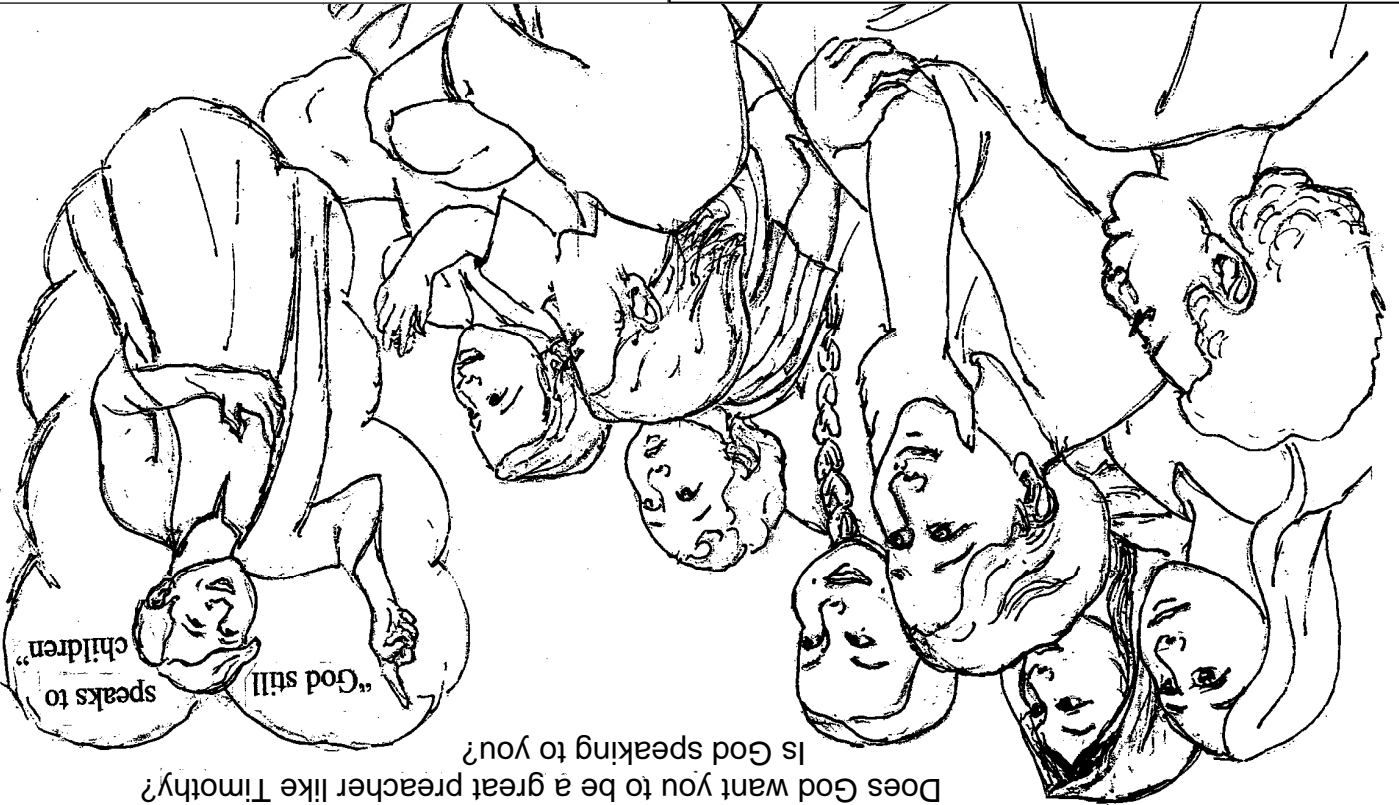

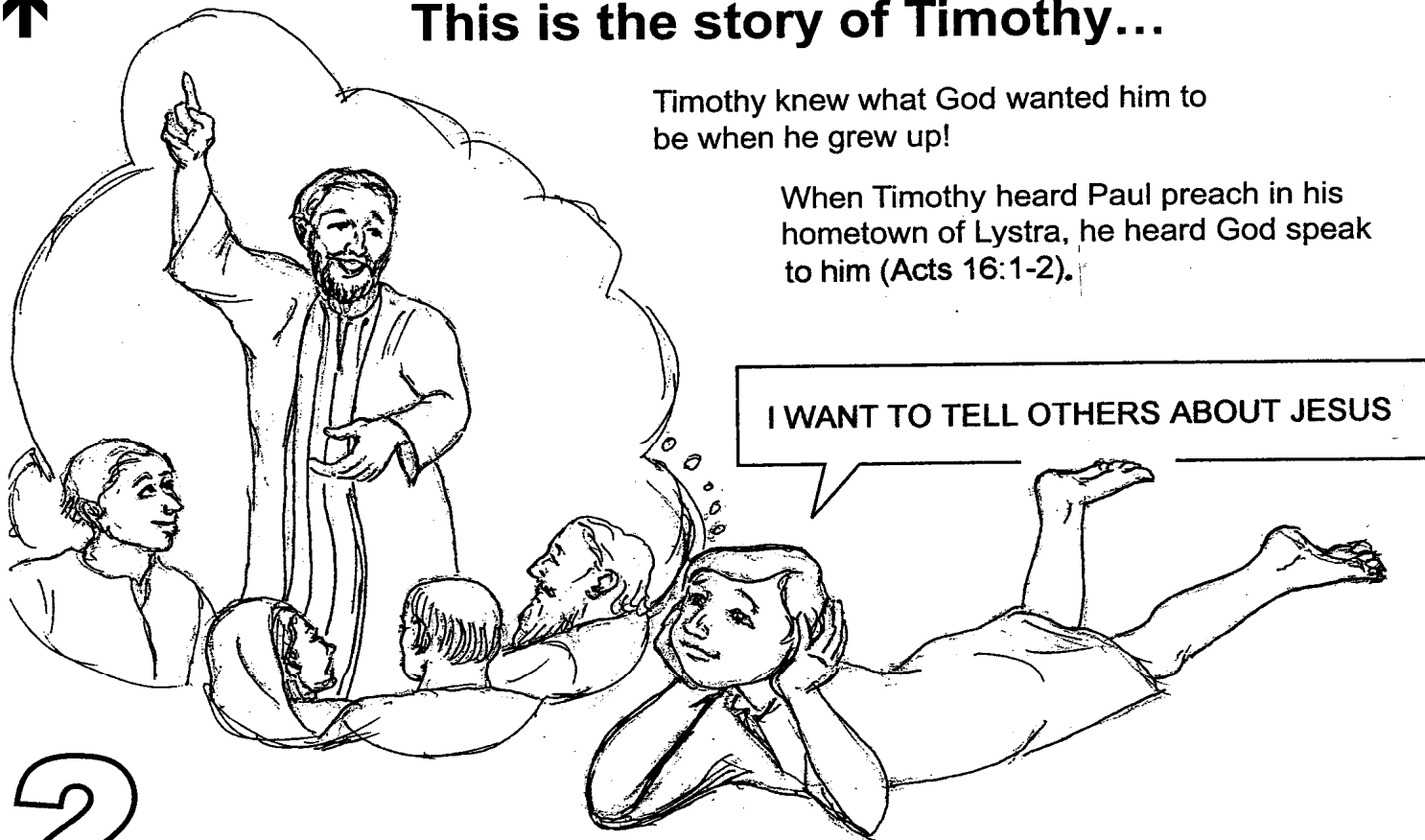




This is the story of Timothy...

Timothy knew what God wanted him to be when he grew up!

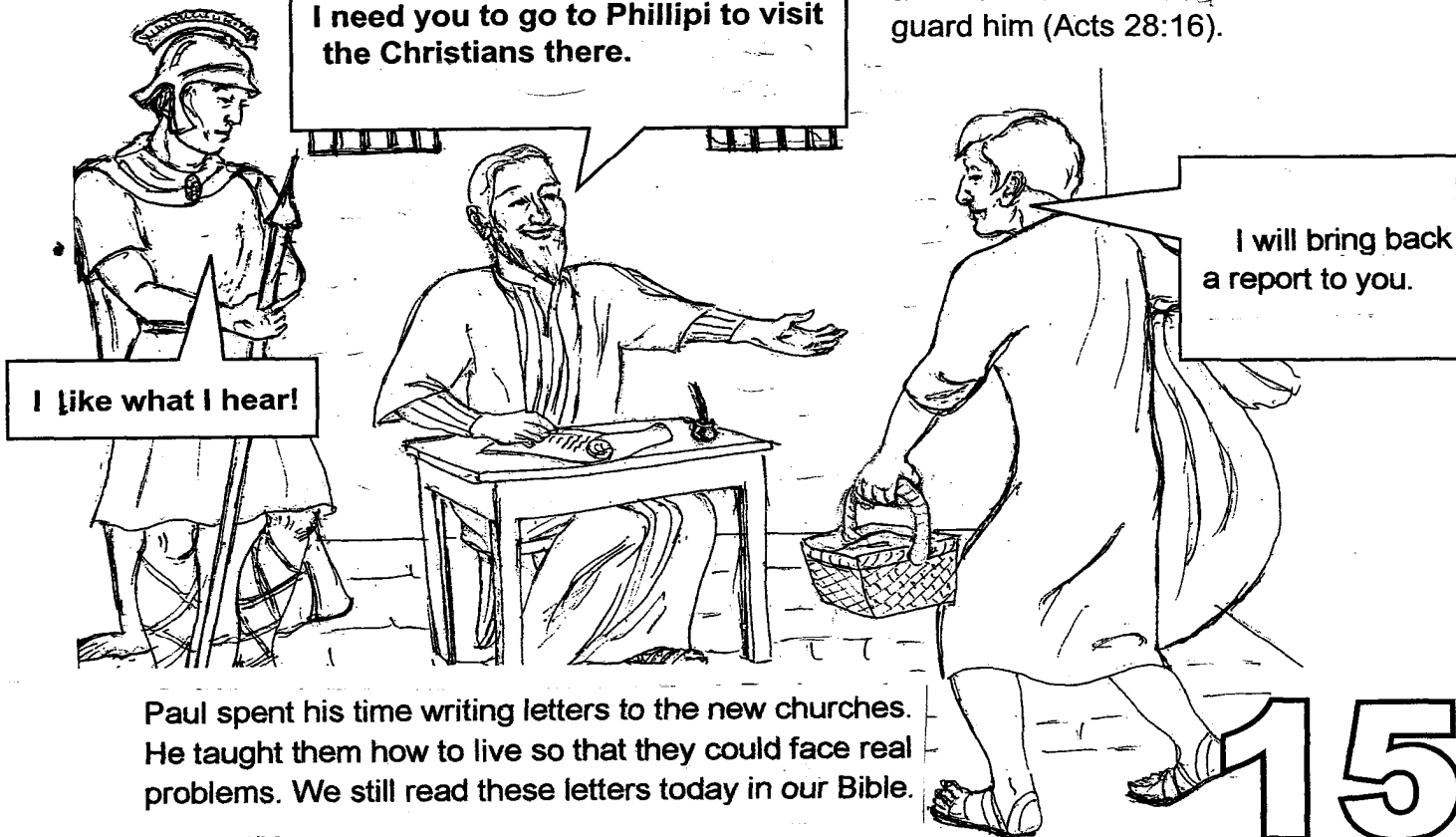
When Timothy heard Paul preach in his hometown of Lystra, he heard God speak to him (Acts 16:1-2).

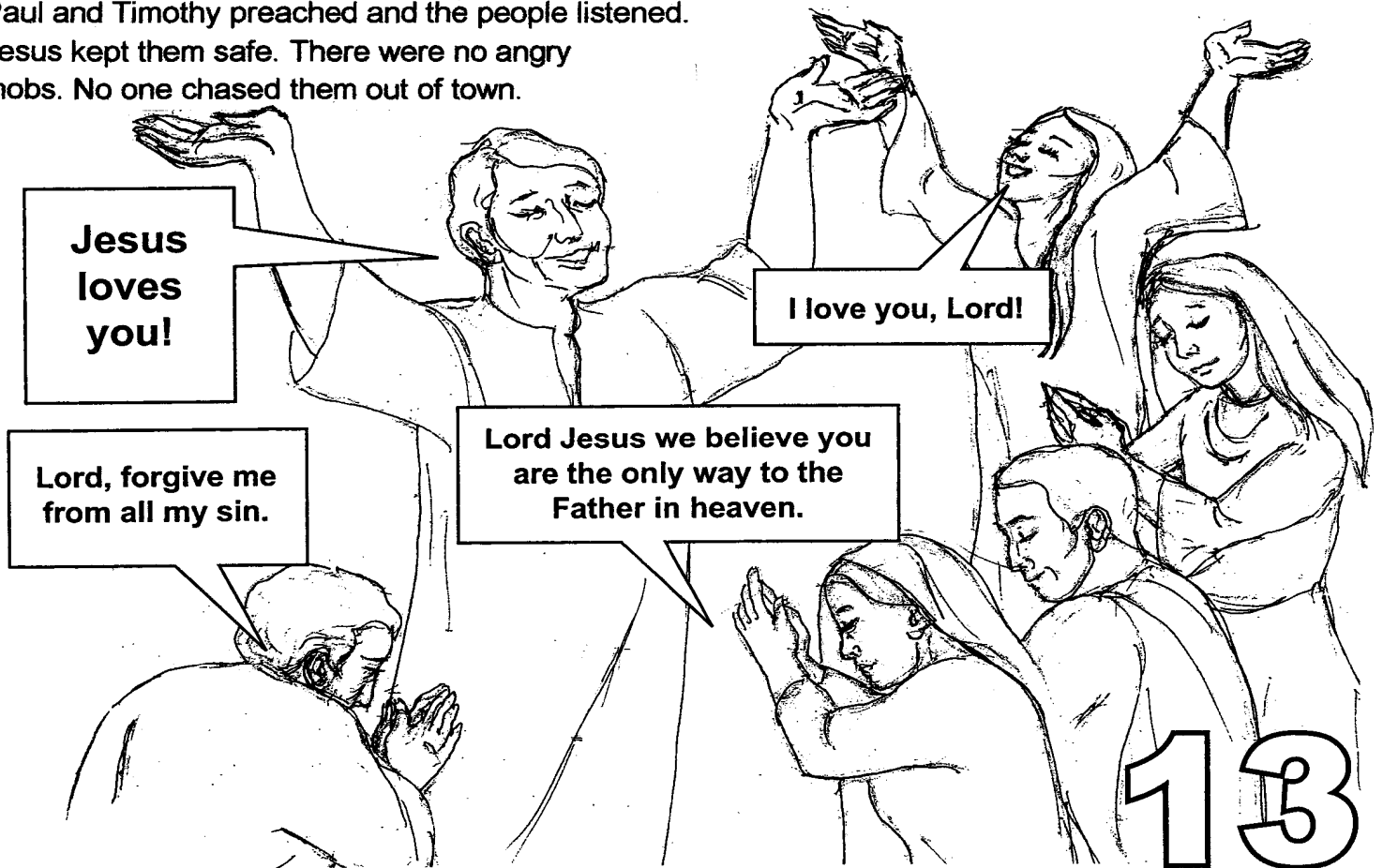


Timothy had a very special family. He loved his mother, Eunice, and his grandmother, Lois. (2 Timothy 1:5)

I love you, Lord!

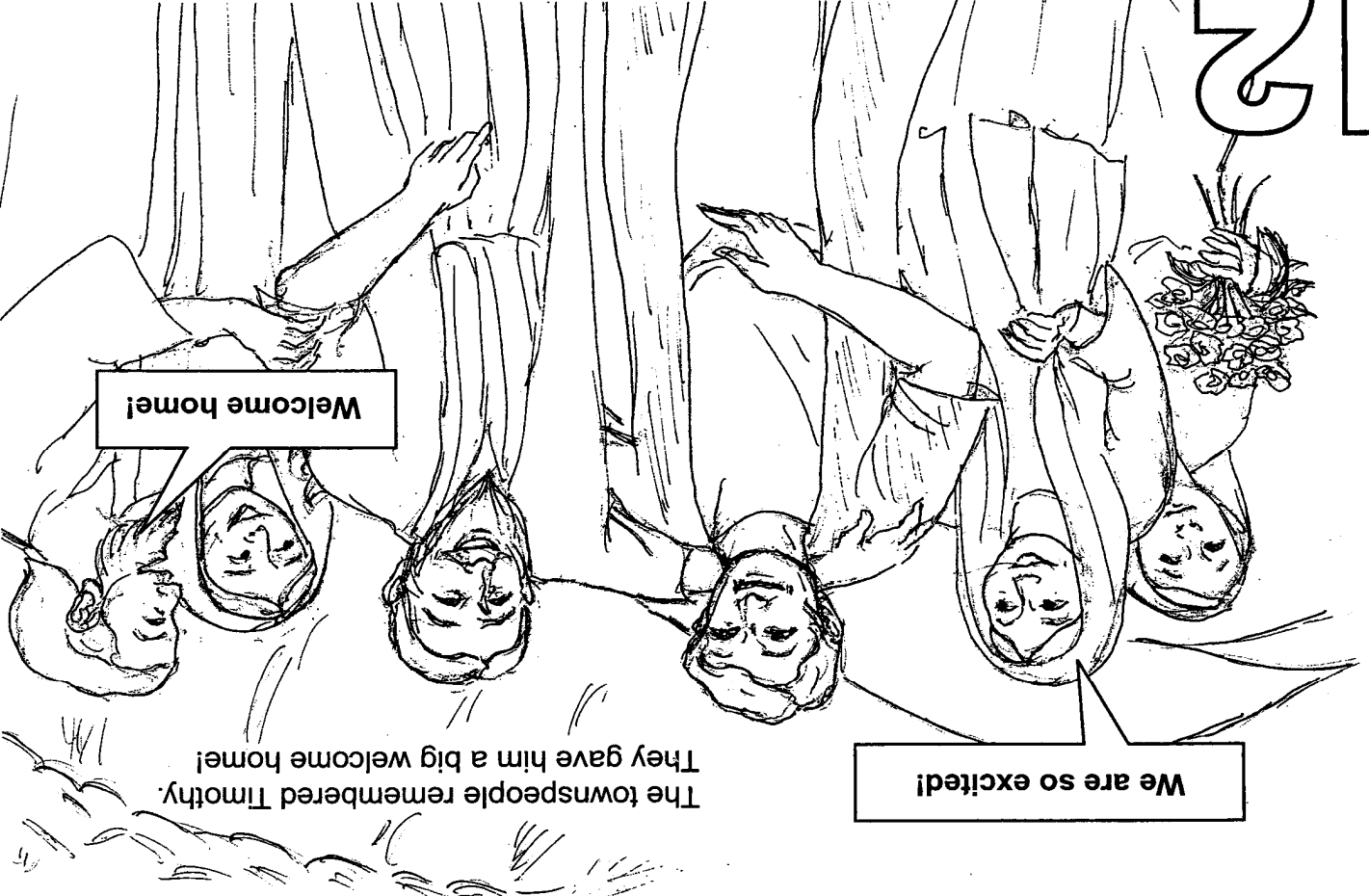
Lord, forgive me from all my sin.

Timothy's mother helped him understand what he was learning about God.



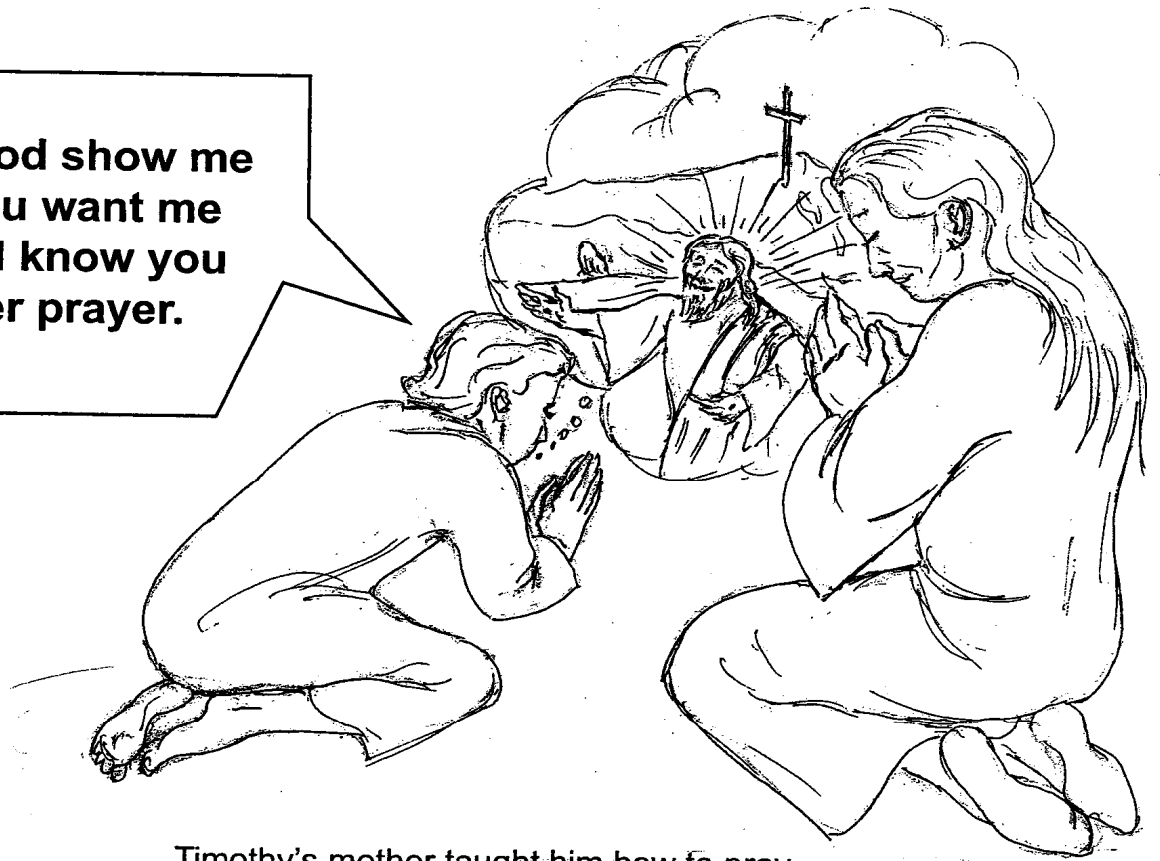
Welcome home!

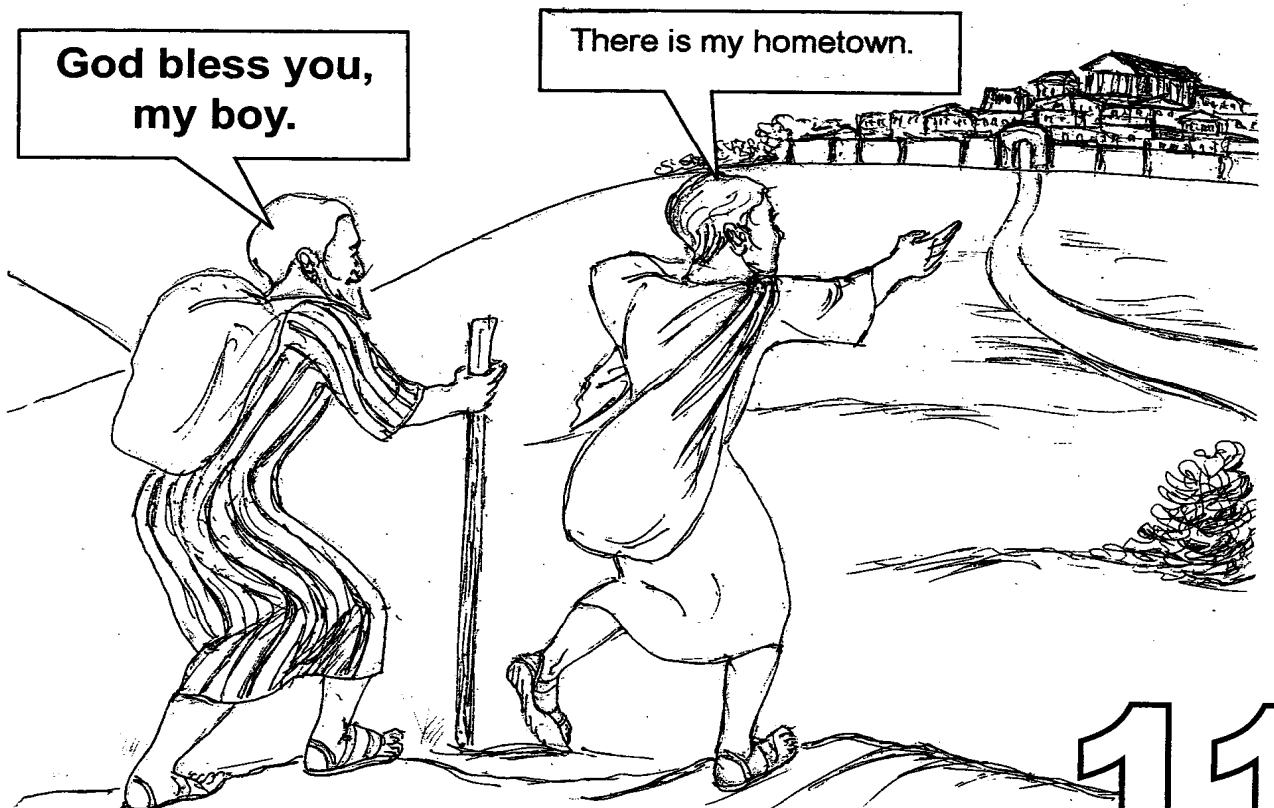

Paul and Timothy climb up the big hill to Lystra. He is excited to be going back to tell the people about Jesus.

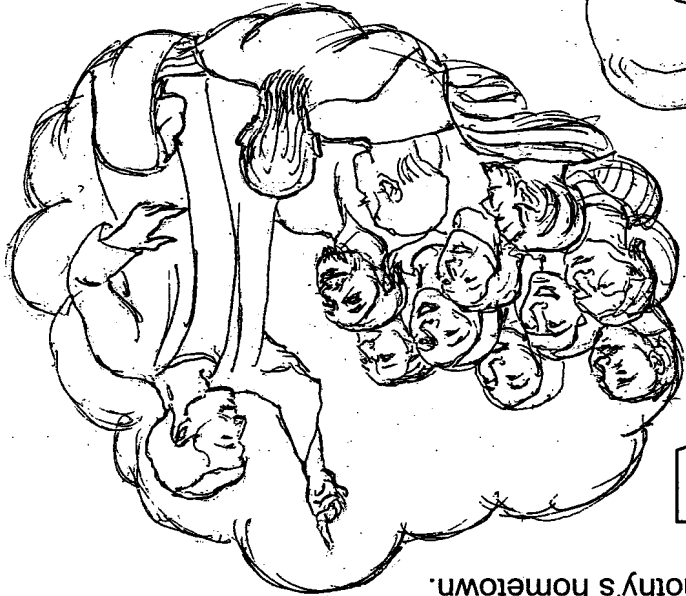
**God bless you,

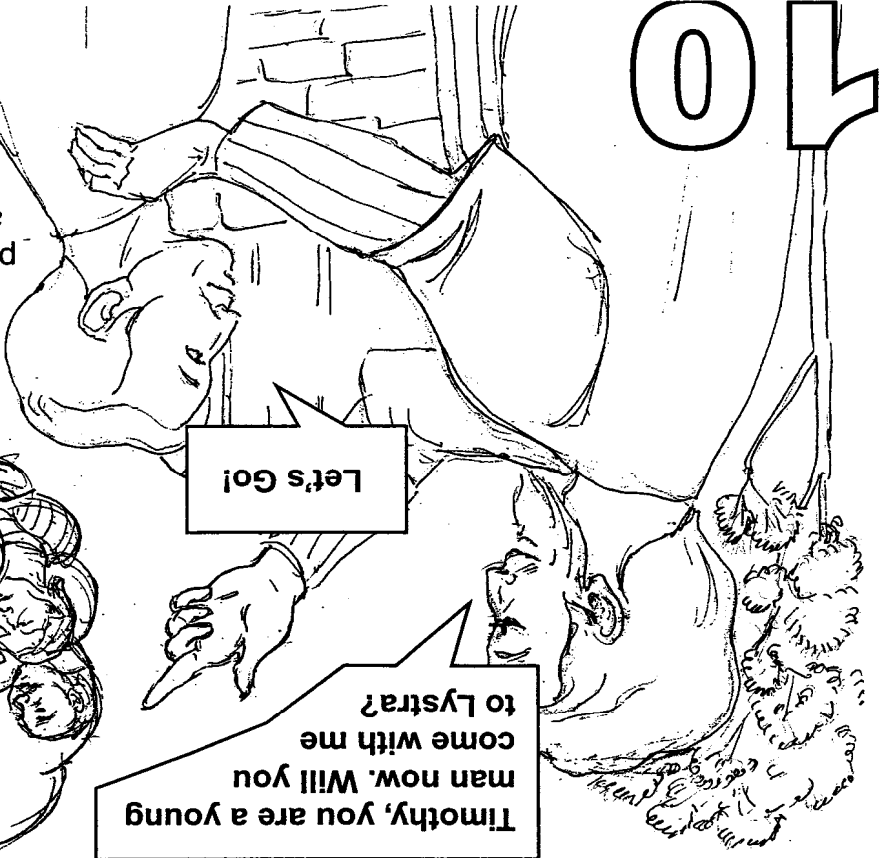
Paul wanted to go on another missionary trip to Timothy's hometown.

Let's Go!



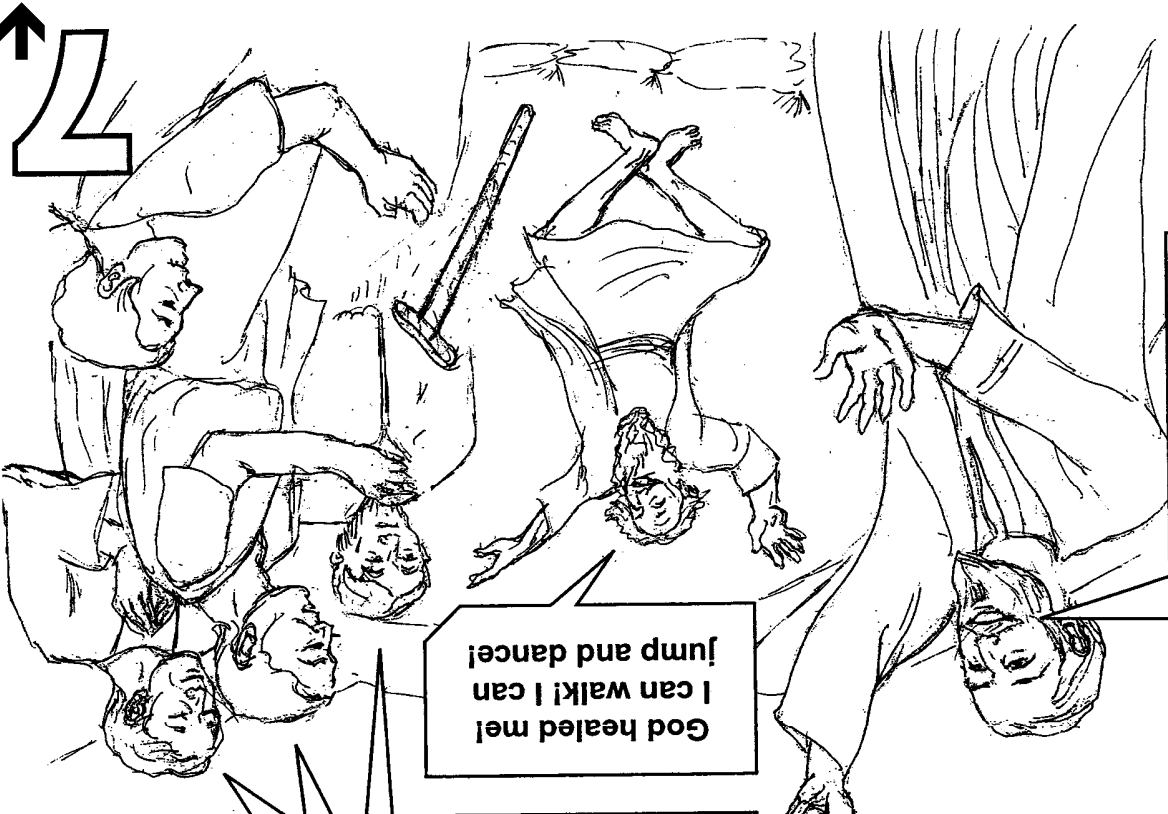

While Paul preached Jesus at Lystra, a crippled man was healed (Acts 14:1-5). The people had never seen a miracle like this.

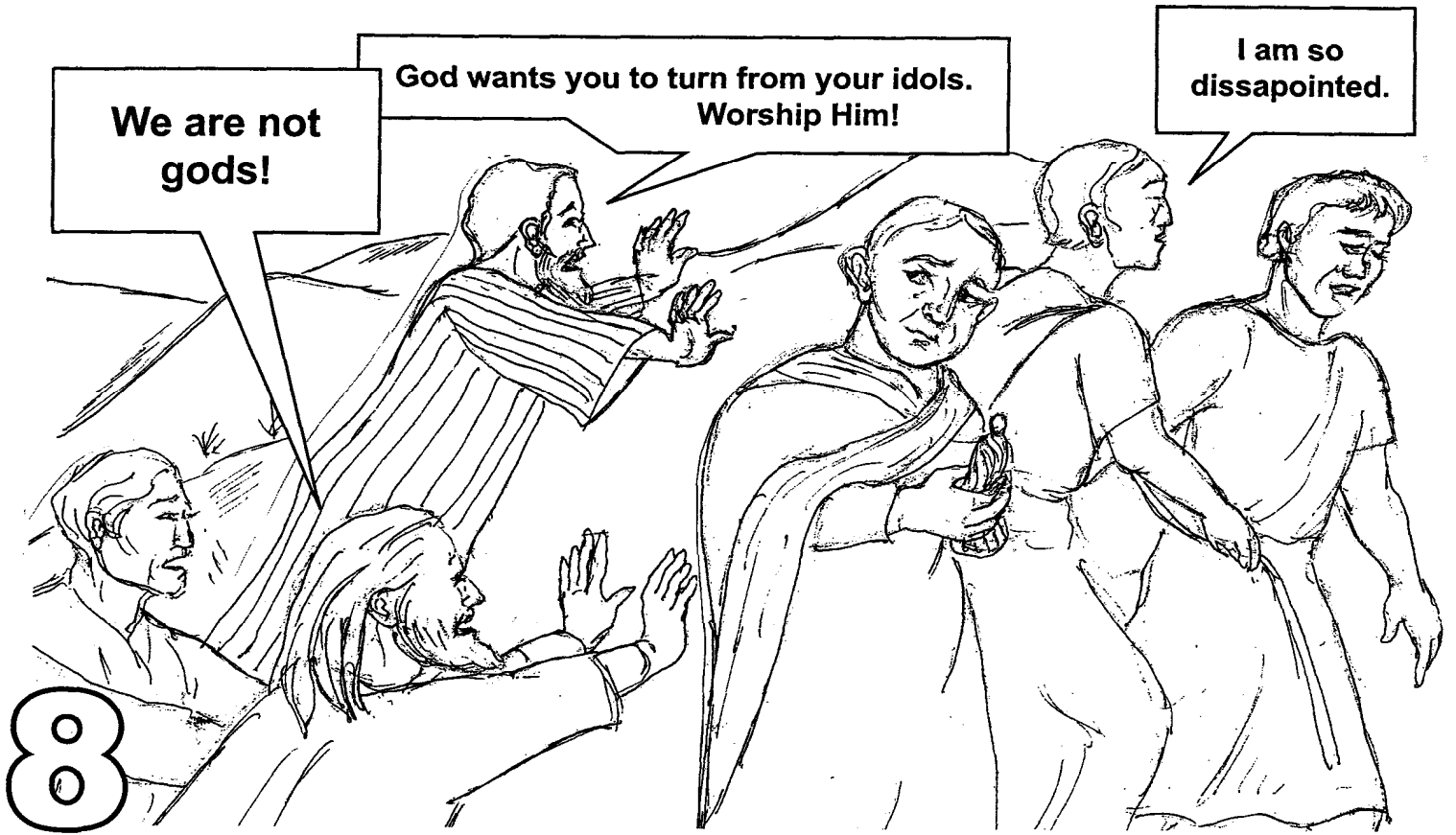
Jesus said, I AM the WAY, the TRUTH, and the LIFE.
