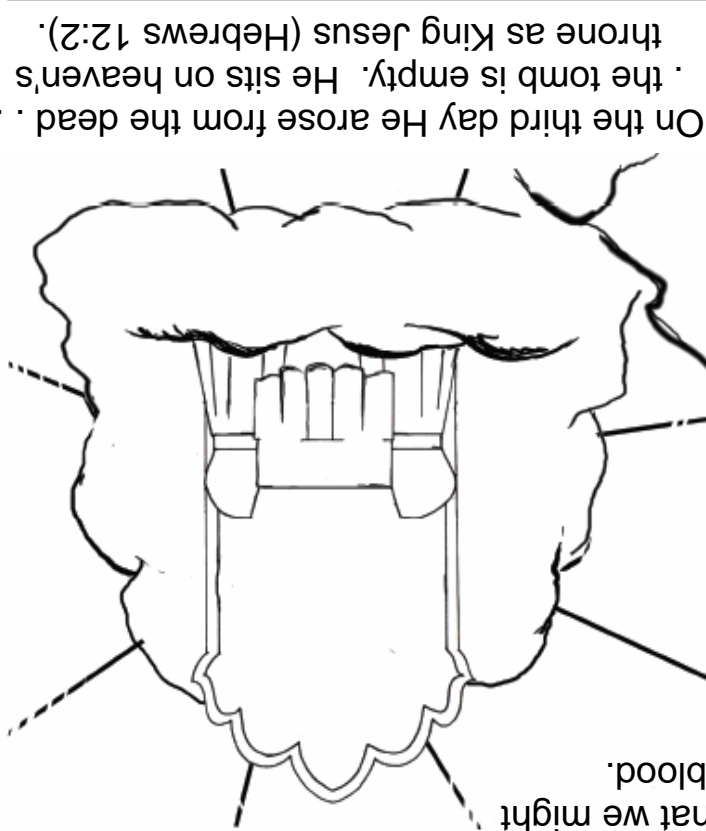

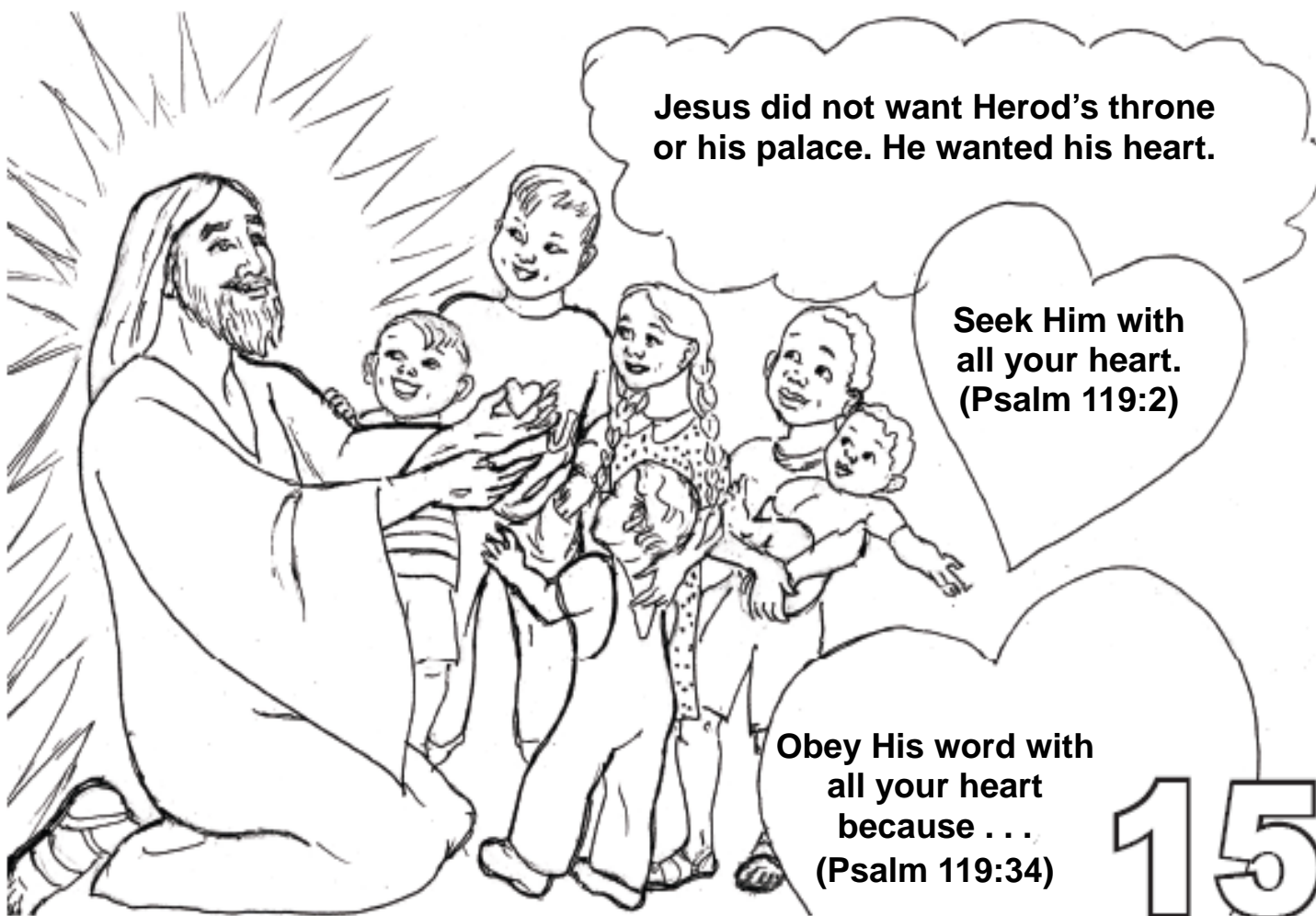
Jesus died that we might be forgiven . . . That we might go to heaven saved by His precious blood.

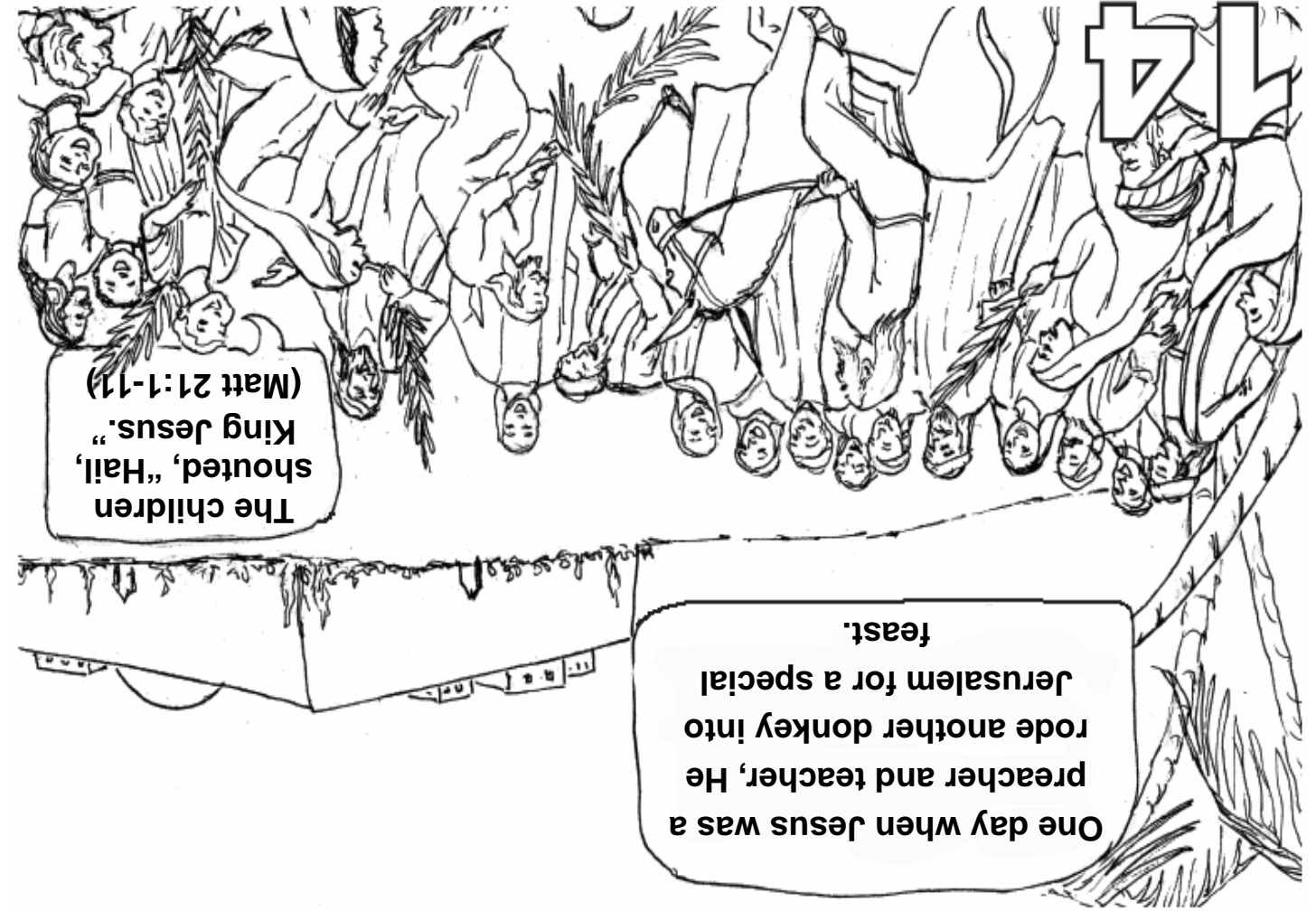


On the third day He arose from the dead .

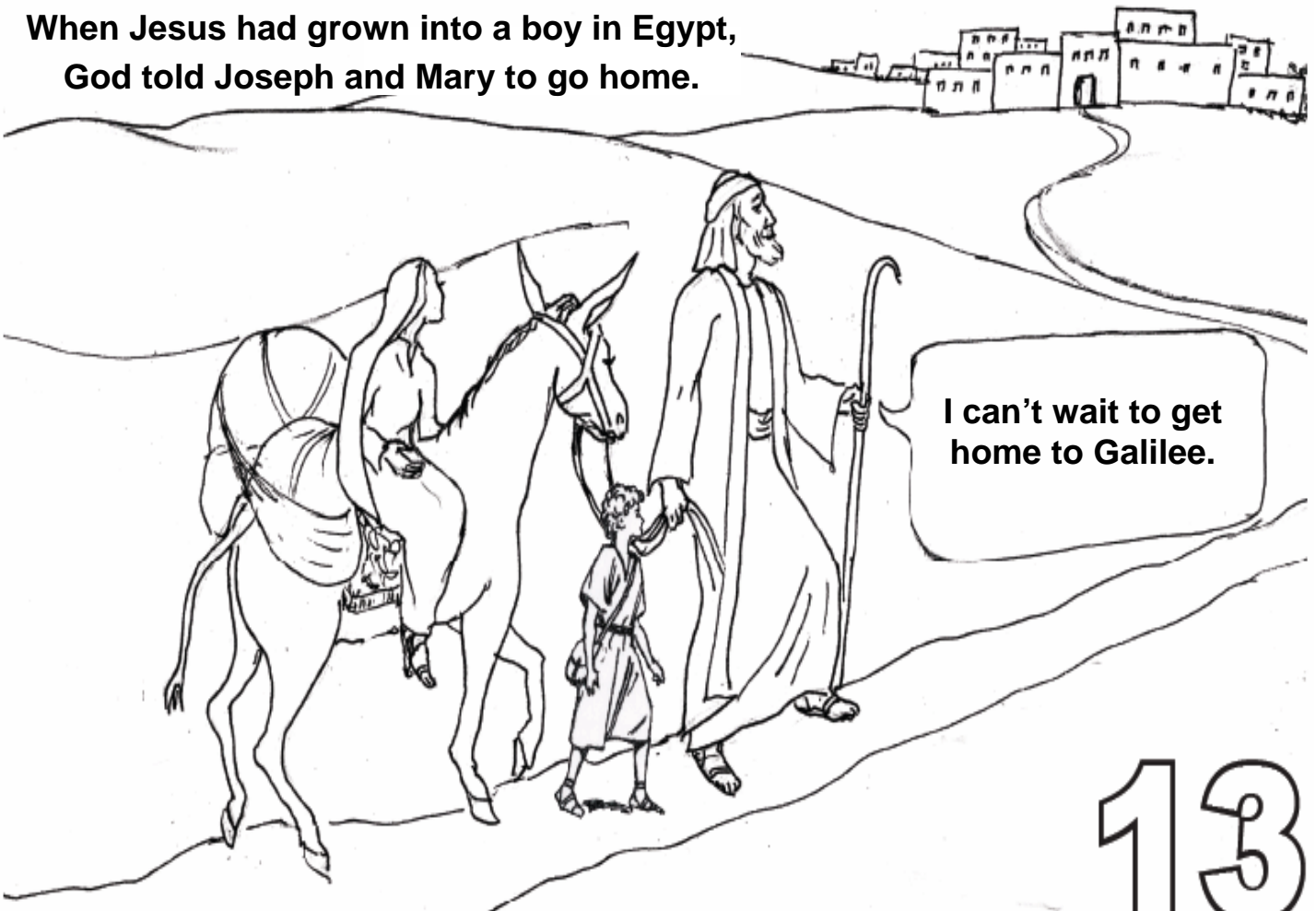


What do the scrolls say?

The scripture says, He will be born in Bethlehem.

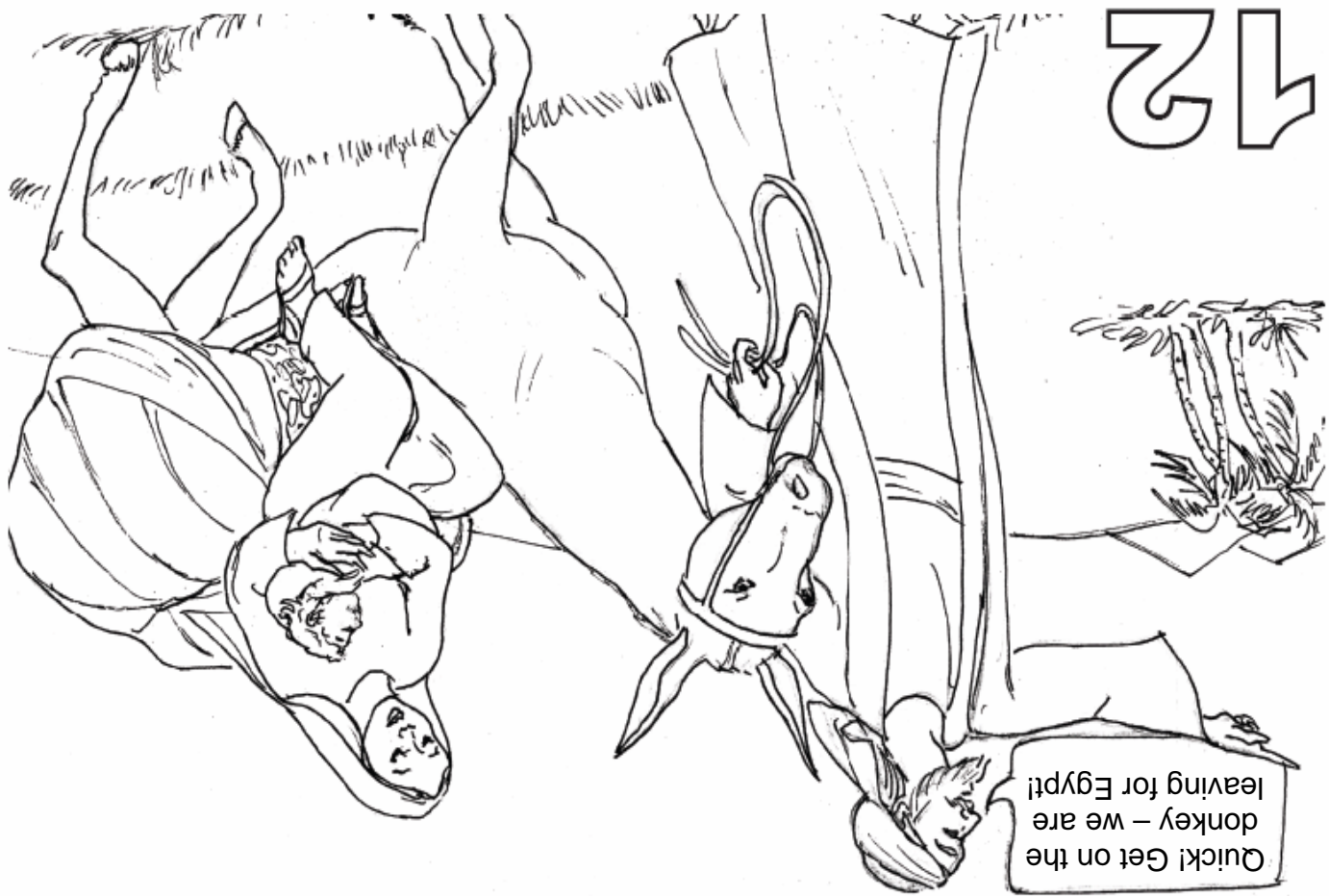


When Jesus had grown into a boy in Egypt,
God told Joseph and Mary to go home.



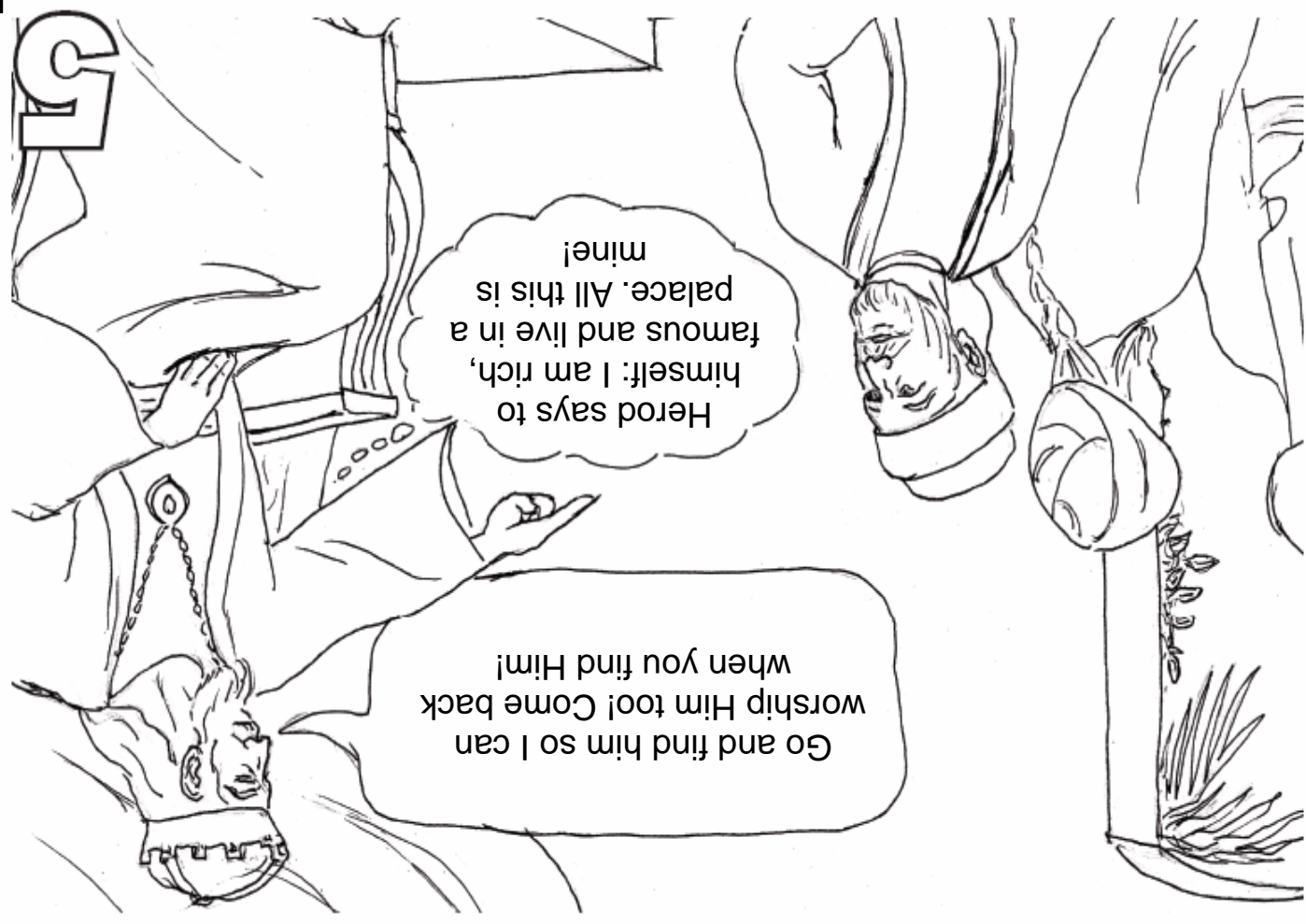

Herod says to himself: I am rich, famous and live in a palace. All this is mine!



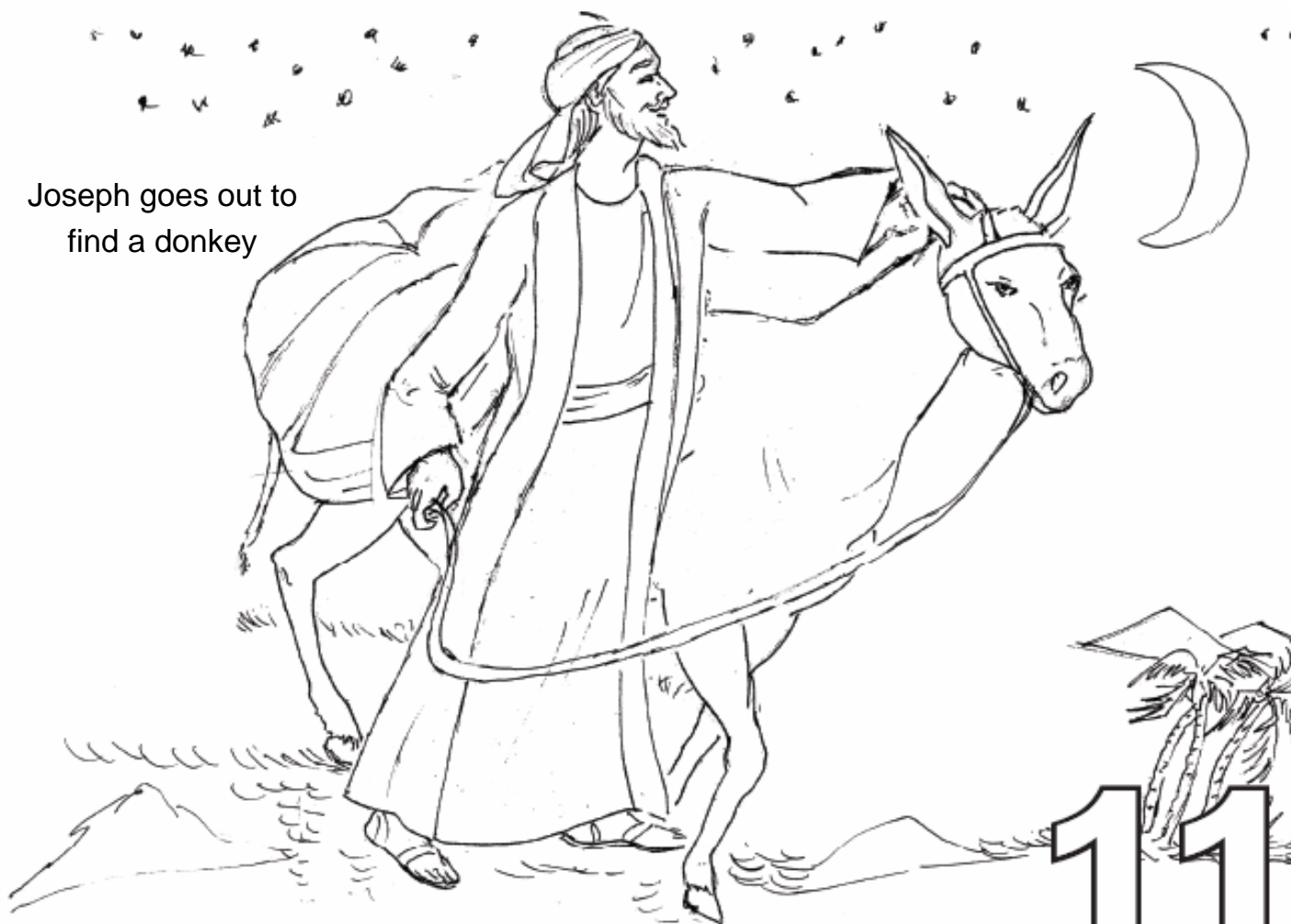

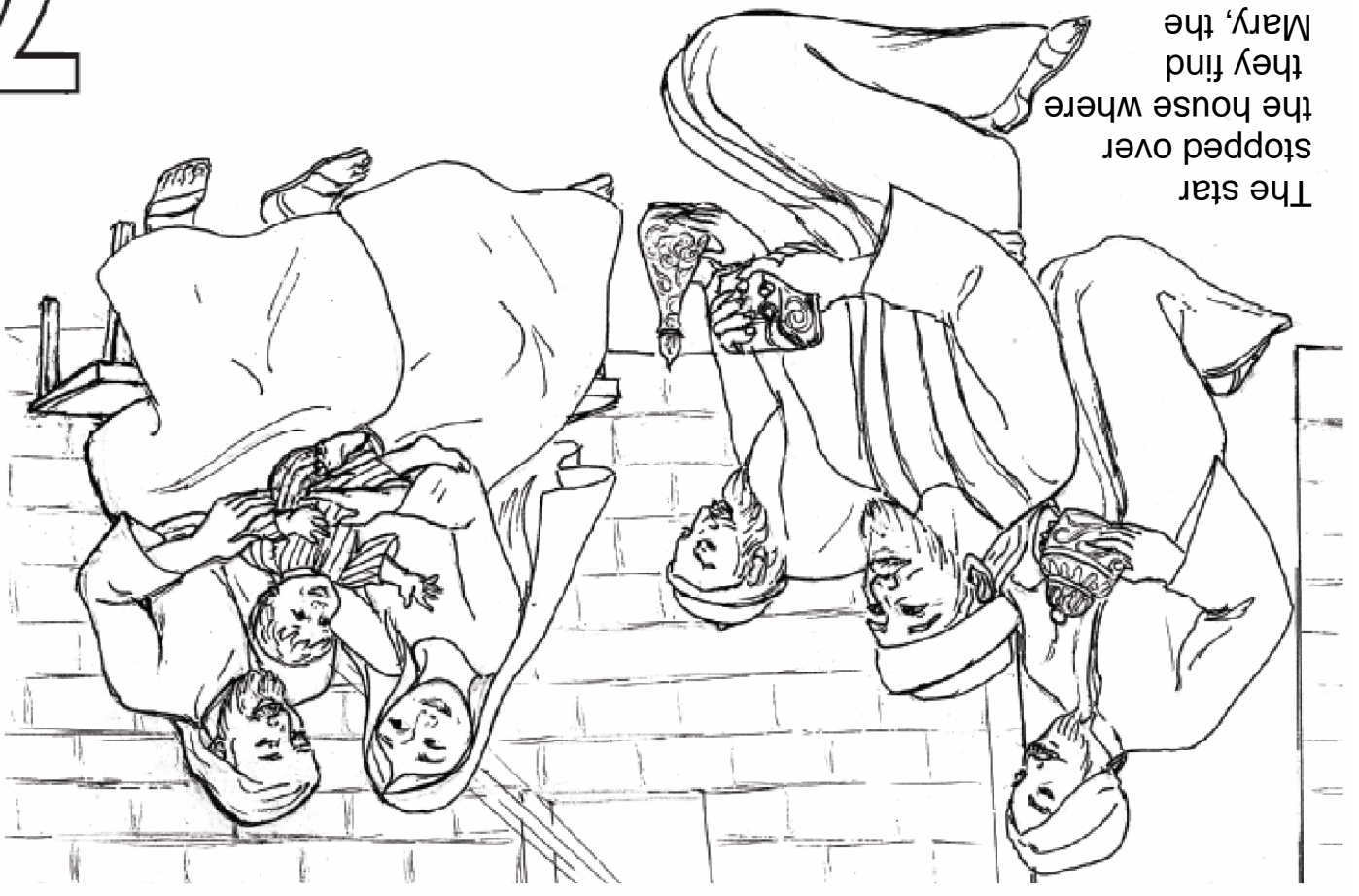
The wise men leave Herod.
